

#### RANCH SORTING

- 1. The mob consists of 11 head of cattle. There will be 10 head of cattle numbered 0 -9 and 1 cleanskin.
- 2. Arena is peanut shape gate line is the narrowest point.
- 3. A team consists of 2 riders.
- 4. Each rider may have multiple rides but must have a different partner for each team.
- 5. The starting number for each team will be announced when the riders and judge are ready. The team will have 5 seconds to cross the gate line and commence sorting the cattle and the clock will start.
- 6. Team starts sorting with the number given by the judge at the commencement of the run and will continue to sort the cattle in upwards numerical order FOR EXAMPLE: YOUR NUMBER IS 6 THEN 7,8,9,0,1,2,3,4,5. The cleanskin must stay in the pen.
- 7. The cattle are considered sorted when the 10<sup>th</sup> beast crosses the gate line and 1 or both team members raises their hand and call for time. The clock will be stopped and a time given.
- 8. No part of horse or rider may cross the gate line at the end of their run or it will be judged NO TIME.
- 9. The time limit will be 90 seconds. A warning will be given with 30 seconds left to go.
- 10. If any cattle cross the gate line out of sequence, the team will be judged NO TIME.
- 11. If cattle already sorted come back over the gate line the team will be judged NO TIME.
- 12. A team must stop sorting immediately when judged NO TIME.
- 13. If a team sorts 10 cattle then time becomes the determining factor for the winner.
- 14. Abuse of cattle or horse will cause disqualification.
- 15. Use of bad language will cause disqualification.
- 16. Helmet and shirt with collar and cuffs must be worn.
- 17. No whips or crops allowed in the arena.
- 18. No contact with the beast by hands or gear allowed disqualification
- 19. No outside assistance is allowed eg. calling numbers, fanning cattle.
- 20. Judges decision is final.
